

CU REGULATORY/INSURANCE AUTHORITIES

National Credit Union Administration (NCUA)

The NCUA charters and supervises credit unions organized under the Federal Credit Union Act. NCUA also administers a federal share insurance program that is mandatory for federal credit unions and optional for state-chartered credit unions.

Headquartered in Alexandria, Virginia, the NCUA has five regional offices. The Austin, Texas office (Region IV) services credit unions in Arkansas, Colorado, Iowa, Illinois, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas and Wyoming.
